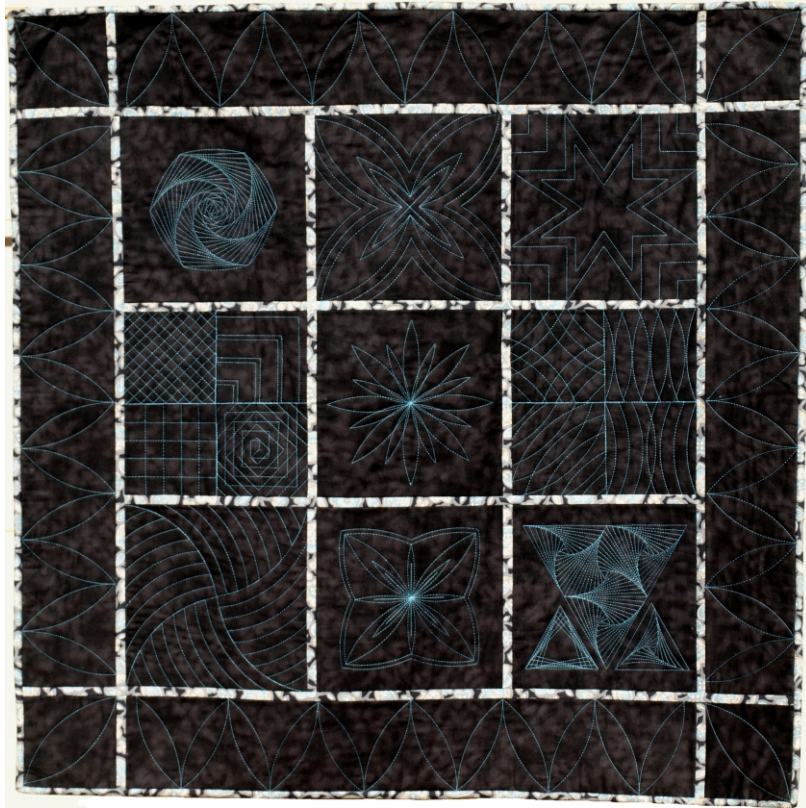

Geometric



This quilt is a sampler quilt designed to be quilted with the Westalee Design 12" Arc Template. This quilt shows the wide range of designs that can be achieved with one template. The quilt blocks are joined using the Westalee Design SashLeeQuilt method.

Fabric requirements:

2mt each, top and bottom fabrics, pressed and starched (includes matching sashing)
70cm Binding fabric
20cm contrasting fabric for top sashing (optional)
40cm contrasting fabric for bottom sashing(optional)
1mt @ 270cm (108") wide Batting

Sewing machine with Extension Table

Silicon Mat

Marking Pen or Pencil (Sewline Duo or Clover Chaco)

Thread, Quilting (Glide) and Piecing

Basting Spray (505)

Needles, Self Threading - Top Threading (Clover) and regular

Size 90/14 Top Stitch Needle (Superior Titanium)

Roxanne's Glue Baste-it

Batting Tape (optional)

Westalee Design Tools needed:

Westalee Design Ruler Foot and 12" Arc Template

Westalee Design SashLeeQuilt Template

Westalee Design Spacing Gauge

Westalee Design 8 point Crosshair Ruler

Westalee Design 6 point Crosshair Ruler (optional)

Westalee Design Bound to Fit - Optional

Cutting Instructions

From each of front, back and batting, cut:

- A** 9 14" x 14" squares
- B** 4 9" x 34" rectangles
- C** 4 9" x 9" squares

From Sashing/Binding fabric, cut:

Front

- 6 1" x 11" *
- 4 1" x 32" *
- 4 1" x 6" *
- 2 1" x 43"

Back

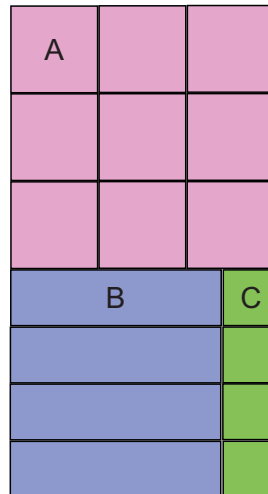
- 6 1³/₄" x 11" *
- 4 1³/₄" x 32"*
- 4 1³/₄" x 6" *
- 2 1³/₄" x 43"

Binding

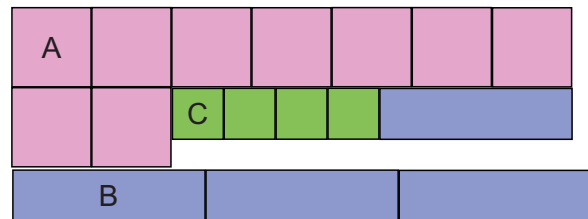
- 5 2¹/₂" x WOF

Note: * see below for matching sashings.

Matching Sashing

For the shorter pieces of sashing (* indicated above) you can use the offcuts of your blocks after trimming. You will only need additional fabric for the longer strips.

Additional fabric requirement if matching fabric:

- Front: 5cm (2")
- Back 10cm (4")

Contrasting Sashing

If you wish to use contrasting sashing you will need additional fabric.

- Front 20cm (1/4 yd)
- Back 40cm (1/2 yd)

Block Marking

- Draw a 10" square, centred within each **A** block
- Draw a box 5" x 31", centred within each **B** block
- Draw a 5" square, centred within each **C** block

After marking your blocks, make quilt sandwiches with the 3 layers. Use basting spray between each layer, make sure to smooth any wrinkles.
