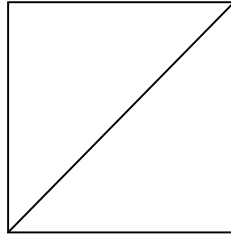


Canberra Quilters' Mystery Quilt 2022

Part 2 - October

You will need the bag marked part 2.

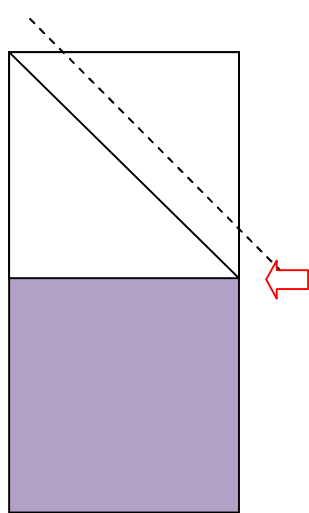
Take each 2.5" background square and draw a line diagonally across the square.



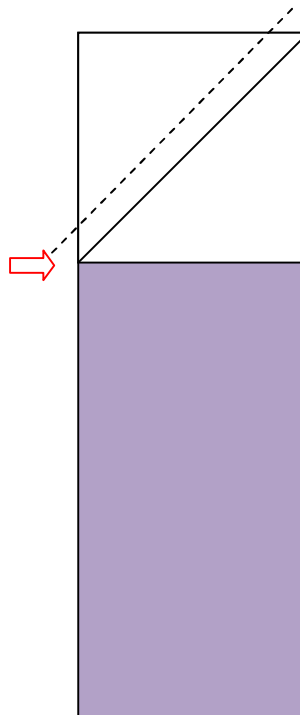
Place the square on each rectangle, making sure to get the direction of the drawn line correct.

Stitch 1 seam, fold over to make sure the lower triangle covers the upper one. If not, sew the seam a fraction towards the upper triangle. This is known as the Sew and Flip way of adding triangles to rectangles.

TIP: I have found it best to sew from the corner of the square that is on the long side of the rectangle (marked with a red arrow). This prevents the corner disappearing down into your machine.

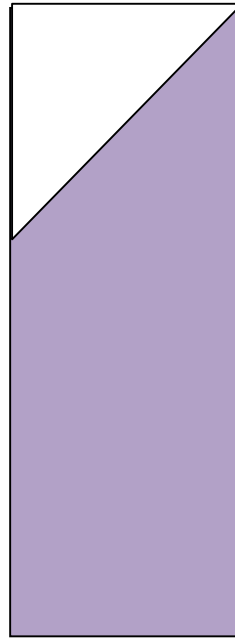
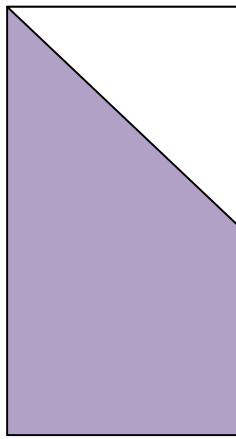


4.5" rectangle



6.5" rectangle

Stitch on the drawn line. Cut on the dotted line leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.



Press the seam on the 4.5" rectangle towards the background triangle.

Press the seam on the 6.5" rectangle towards the rectangle.

Pin each of the 4 matching rectangles with corner triangles together and pop back into the bag marked part 2.
