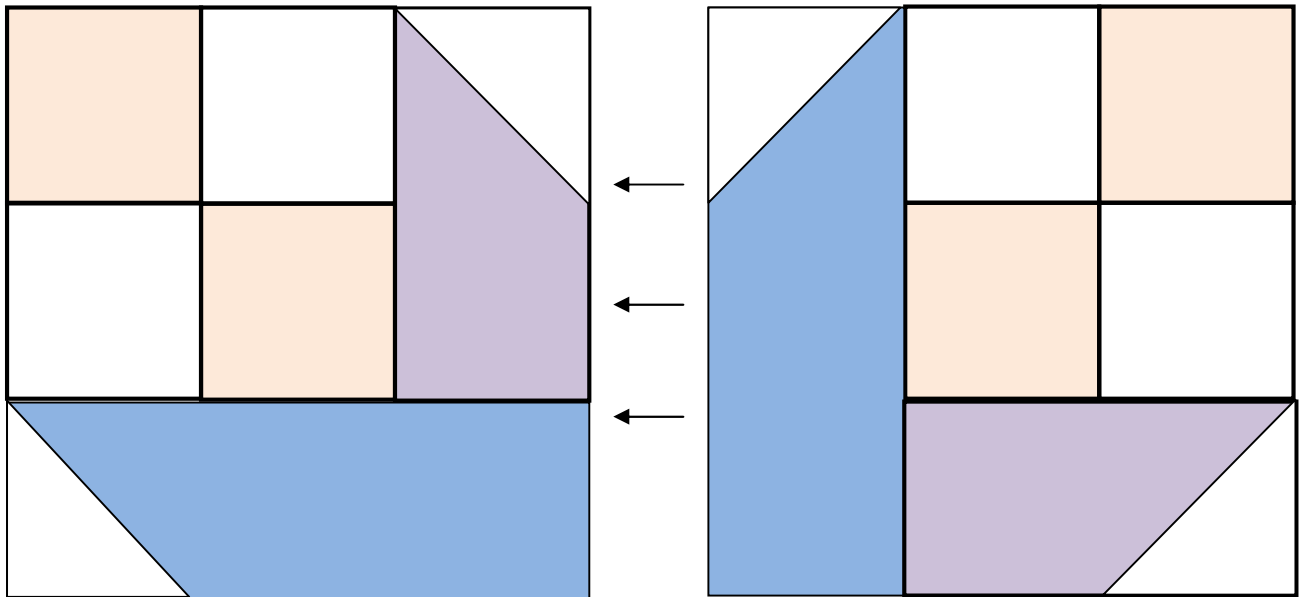


Canberra Quilters' Mystery Quilt 2022

Part 4 - December

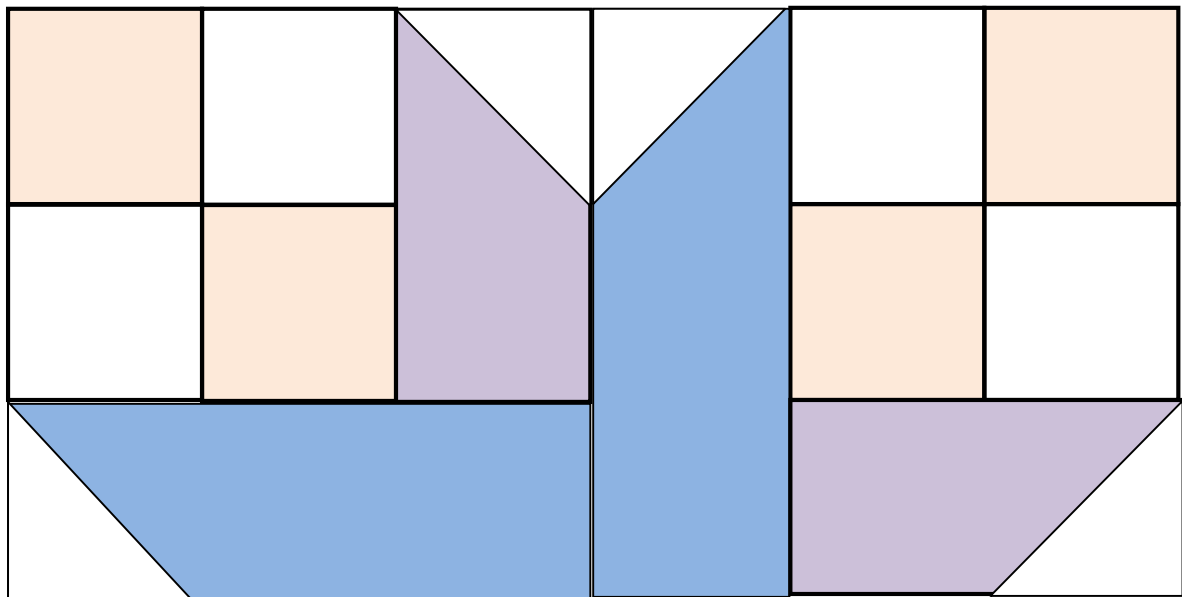
Now it's time to make the blocks.

Take each group of four (4) 6.5" blocks made in part 3. You should have 4 the same (or similar) pinned together. Join together into pairs (making both pairs identical). The triangle corners should nest together when stitching the seam.

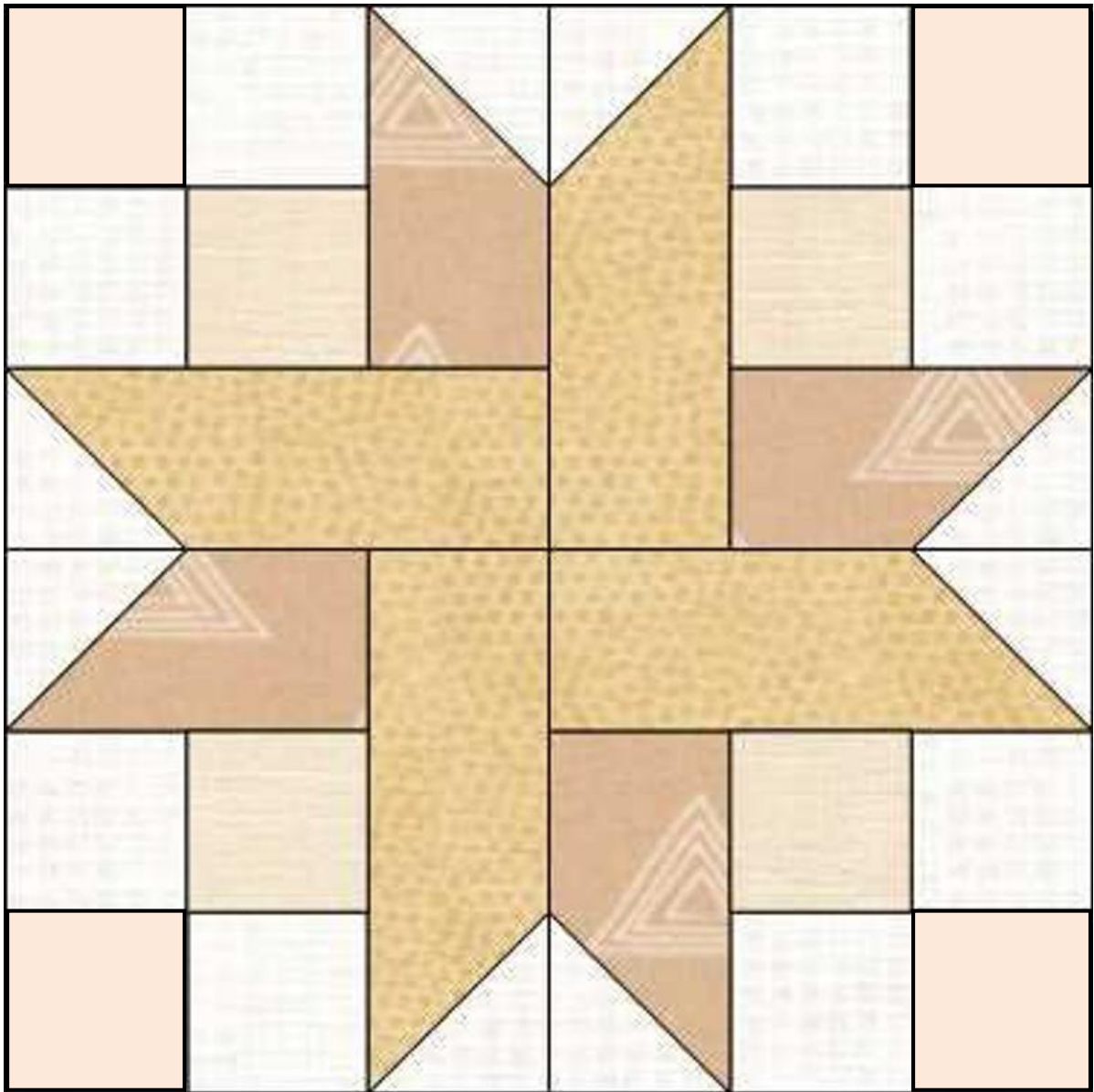


Press seam towards the right block.

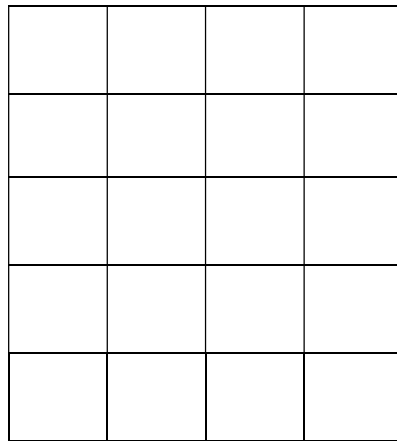
Make 20 groups of 2 matching sets.



Take each pair of blocks and join together, pressing seams. You will have 20 blocks, each should measure 12.5" square (unfinished).



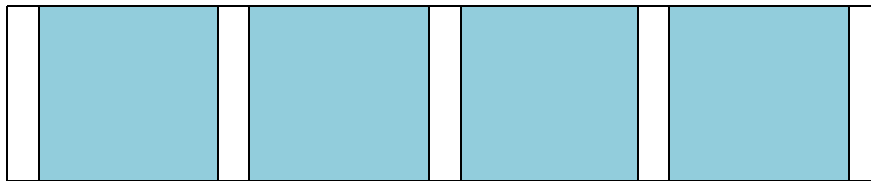
Lay your blocks out into 5 rows of 4 blocks.



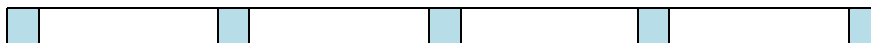
Take your 12.5" strips from the part 4 bag.

Join your blocks together with the strips into 5 rows of 4 blocks, with a strip on both outside ends of the rows.

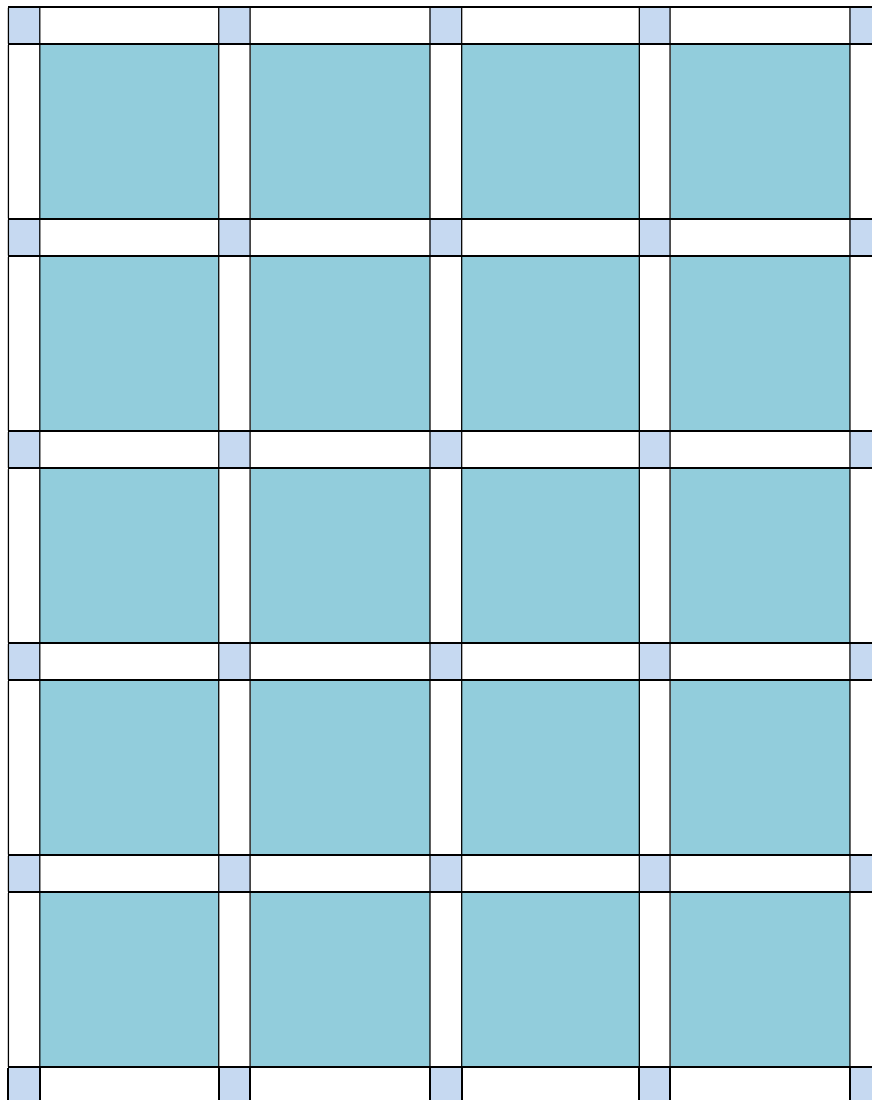
Press seams towards the narrow strip. (Block row)



Join the 2.5" squares together with the 12.5" strips. Make rows. Press seams towards the 12.5" strip. (Sashing Row). You will have 6 sashing rows.



Join the sashing rows and the blocks rows, alternating them, pressing seams towards the sashing row. For ease of construction and pressing, I find it easier to add a sashing row to a block row and press. Do this for each block row, then sew each combined block/sashing row to the next one, adding the final sashing row at the end.



Congratulations, you have now completed the quilt top.

Quilt as desired.
